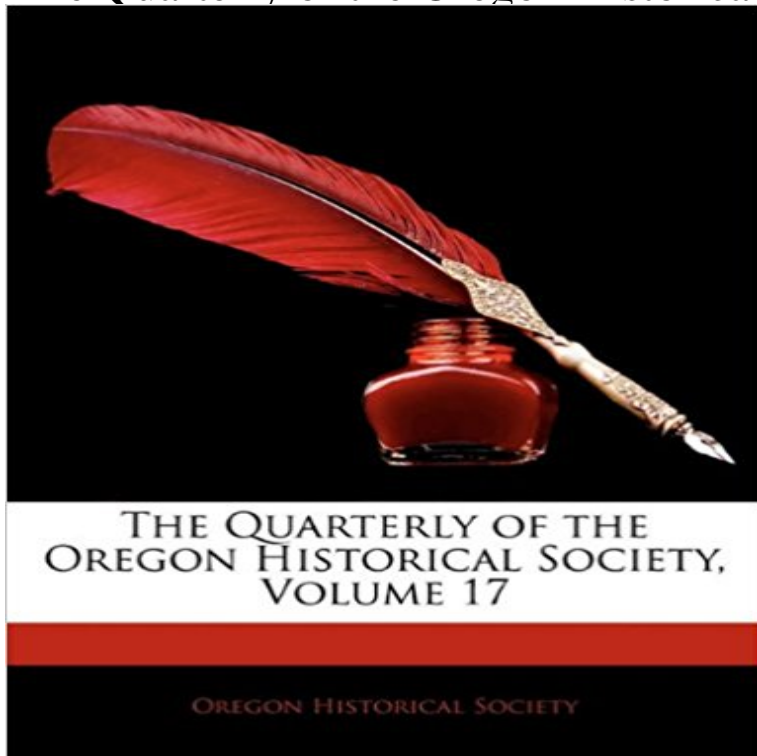


The Quarterly of the Oregon Historical Society, Volume 17
