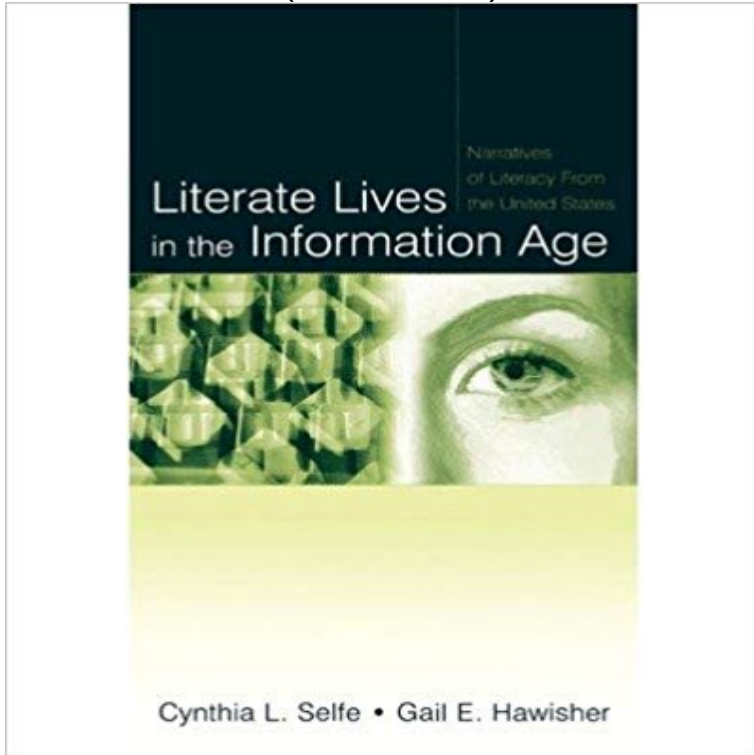


Literate Lives in the Information Age: Narratives on Literacy from the United States (Hardback) - Common
