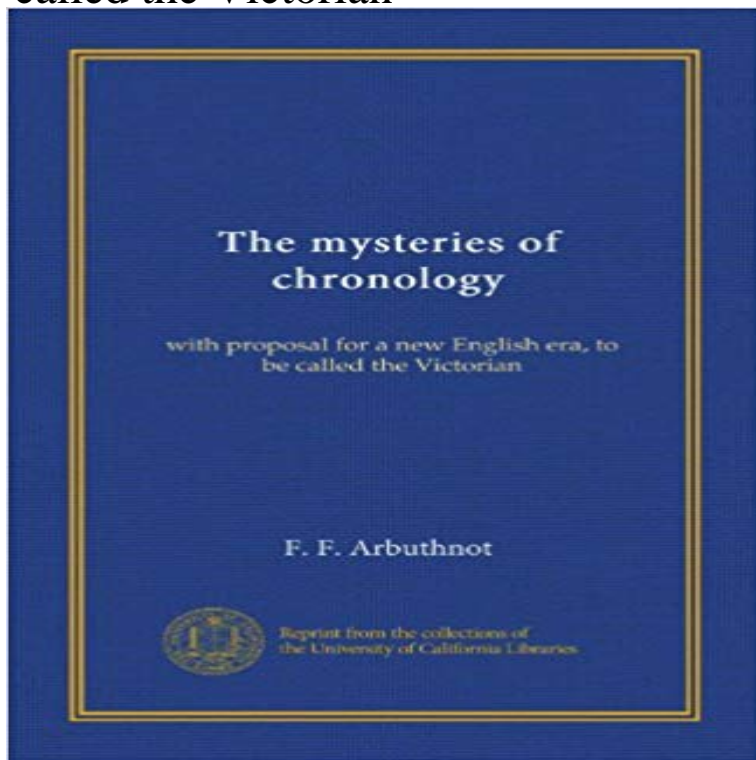


The mysteries of chronology: with proposal for a new English era, to be called the Victorian
