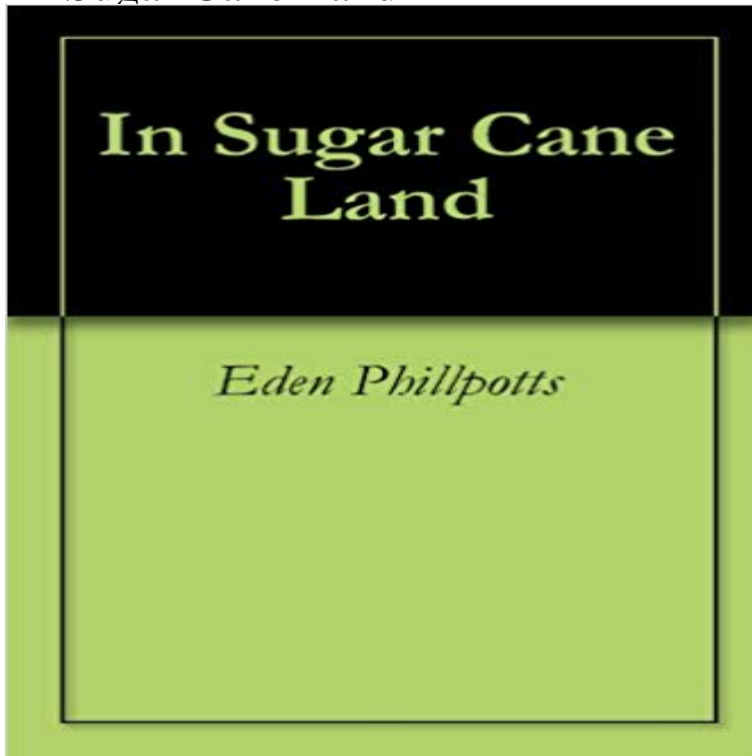


## In Sugar Cane Land
